Welcome to Hazeldown School.

The following Agreement of partnership is designed to remind us all of our rights and responsibilities in educating your children.

- Everyone has the right not to be hurt whilst at school

The Head Teacher has signed on behalf of the school and we ask parents and children to sign under their sections.

Please read through the document with your child before asking them to sign.

The child agrees :

- To treat people and property with respect
- To follow instructions given by an adult
- To listen carefully to others, especially adults
- To put in 100% effort all of the time
- To be well prepared for school and wear the correct uniform
- To work hard to play my part in keeping our social bond

The school agrees to:

- Provide a full and balanced curriculum to meet the needs of all children and all abilities.
- Strive to educate each pupil to the best of his/her ability to meet nationally agreed standards.
- Provide records and information about your child's educational progress as well as the child's development in practical and social skills,
- Send home appropriate home-learning activities and books to read.
- Arrange regular meetings with your child's teacher(s) and be available at other times when you have concerns or questions.
- Let you know immediately if there is a concern regarding your child at school and work together on the causes/problems.
- Welcome all parents who wish to help in the daily work of the school.
- Keep you informed about new policies and developments in school.
- Handle parents' complaints sensitively and as soon as possible.
- Liaise appropriately with external support agencies in the best interests of your child.

The parent agrees to:

- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and work with the school to encourage a positive attitude to education.
- Ensure that my child/children attend school regularly and punctually (school begins at 8:50am)
- Try not to take my child on holiday in term time.
- Let the school know the reason for my child's absence before 9:10am.
- Ensure that my child has a reasonable night's sleep before coming to school and has the correct uniform and equipment needed.
- Check my child's head regularly and take all necessary measures to keep hair free of head lice.
- Give some time to talk with and listen to my child, support with home-learning activities, and give positive support to efforts and progress my child has made.
- Attend as many meetings and celebration events as possible at school to discuss my child's progress and to learn about the work of the school.
- Check the school newsletter and website for up to date information.
- Encourage my child to read, listen to them and talk to them about their books
- Encourage my child to use the media and the internet selectively, supporting them in their safe use .
- Work together with the school to share information about concerns or problems that affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Let the school know if I have any concerns about my child's education.
- Let the school know if there are any factors which may affect my child's performance in school.
- Liaise appropriately with external support agencies in the best interests of my child.
- Park safely and considerately, not on the zig-zag markings to support the school in keeping children safe.
